1875	<b>DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST</b>  No declarations of interest were made in respect of the items that follow below.
1876	<b>EXCLUSION OF THE PRESS AND PUBLIC</b>  <b>Agreed</b> – that, in accordance with the provisions of Section 100(A)(4) of the Local Government Act, 1972, the public (including the Press) be excluded from the meeting for the following items of business, minute 1877, on the grounds that it involve the likely disclosure of exempt information as defined in paragraph 2 of Part 1 of Schedule 12A of the Act information which is likely to reveal the identity of an individual and the public interest in maintaining the exemption outweighs the public interest in disclosing the information.
1877	<b>COMPLAINT</b>  The Board considered a complaint from a member of the public, that was brought to them, in accordance with section 4.3 of the Service Complaints Policy and Procedure 2017.  <b>Agreed</b> – That having considered the substantial documentation before them, the Board determined that following the detailed and thorough investigations carried out by the Chief Port Health Inspector, leading to the detailed decision letters at stages 4.1 and 4.2 in the Procedure, the findings of the Chief Port Health Inspector are correct and the decisions are therefore upheld by this review.
